

1. INTRODUCTION

- Special challenge (not only) for child and youth welfare minors with psychological strain, mental disability and aggressive violent behaviour
- Often cases including need for educational and psychiatric / psychological help
- But:

Cooperation deficits between links in the system of help for a lot of these minors!

2.ISSUES AND TARGET GROUP

Issues:

- Links between child and youth welfare, psychological and psychiatric care and forensic commitment will be shown and developed
- Appropriate organizational structures and models of cooperation will be installed
- Existing terms of cooperation will be strengthened
- If necessary new measures will be developed and introduced

3. REVIEW / REQUIREMENTS

- Hamburg has access to a varied range of help in child and youth welfare
- Existing measures and services are inadequately for our target group of troubled minors
- The links to child and adolescent psychiatry shows a urgent need for action, especially settling financial questions (different legal provisions SGB V health care und SGB VIII child and youth welfare for social services)

3. REQUIREMENTS

- Support for case management (empowering private agencies in developing binding procedures, individual settings)
- Reliable cooperations
- Transition between child and youth welfare and child and adolescent psychiatry
- New offers of help, mixed settings, mixed professions
- Maintenance of standards in placement of minors in the forensic department (special spacious conditions, individual medical treatment, educational help), individual setting if necessary, terms of transition

Multisystemic therapy (MST):

- Intensive, family focussed and community based treatment
- Target group: juvenile offenders with severe psychological and behavioural problems

What is MST about?

- Intervention over four or six month
- Licenser MST Services (US)
- Based on structural / strategic family therapy, cognitive behaviour therapy, ecological system theory
- 24/7 service
- Team: 2-4 professionals, 1 supervisor
- One agency implements all measures

Binding procedure for interdisciplinary case teams (have the power to make decisions)

- Coordination office (conducted by youth welfare)
- District youth welfare
- Local psychologists, psychiatrists
- School
- Child and adolescent psychiatry

Institution for troubled minors (not closed)

- Focus on
 - mentally disabled

- Accompanied conditions
 - severe psychological and behavioural problems

Institution with educational and psychiatric care:

Focus on severe psychological and behavioural problems

- Accompanied conditions:
 - delinquency
 - educational help
 - psychological / psychiatric help

Close inpatient institution

- Focus on delinquency
- Accompanied conditions:
 - severe psychological and behavioural problems
 - target group crosses permanently the line between child and youth welfare and child and adolescent psychiatry

5. SUMMARY AND OUTLOOK

What we need

- Reliable cooperations
- Binding procedures for interdisciplinary case teams
- Different institutions for different target groups

What we are going to do

- Working on the frame conditions
 - settling financial questions
